

Packaging is sent from the central warehouse to retail stores, then returned after use for inspection, restocking, and reuse. — Warehouse locations



Shipments move from the central warehouse to various office locations and are later returned for reuse in the next delivery cycle.


— Recurring B2B customers 🍕



Goods are delivered from the central warehouse to recurring business customers, who return the packaging via back-haul or pick-up. Recurring B2C customers



Packaging is dispatched from the central warehouse to end consumers, who return it via designated return points or collection on next delivery.



Tracking and reporting requires integration to existing WMS scans, webhooks of TrackWise open API.

Regulatory demands

TrackWise helps your company stay ahead of regulatory demands through traceability, documentation, and reporting – fully aligned with EU packaging legislation. Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR)

National EPR schemes are increasingly based on environmental performance. Using TrackWise enables fee reduction and proves packaging is kept in circulation.

Green Claims Directive (GCD)

Claims like "reusable packaging" must be backed by measurable, verified data. TrackWise generates auditable reports to ensure marketing and compliance teams can make science-based claims.

Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR)

PPWR requires 100 % of packaging for internal transport logistics or domestic B2B flows to be reusable by 2030. TrackWise provides verifiable data to document reusable packaging within a reuse system.

Directive (CSRD)

TrackWise delivers granular, auditable reuse data that feeds directly into Scope 3 emission accounting and circularity metrics under ESRS.
